OHIO MUTUAL INSURANCE GROUP DONATES \$100,000 TO CHILDREN'S HUNGER ALLIANCE TO HELP FEED CHILDREN IMPACTED BY COVID-19

Columbus, OH (April 6, 2020) – Bucyrus-based Ohio Mutual Insurance Group (OMIG) presented Children's Hunger Alliance (CHA) with a check for \$100,000 to help feed children across Ohio amid the coronavirus outbreak. Many children's lives have been disrupted with school closures and loss of jobs. OMIG wanted to support the statewide nonprofit to help feed kids at risk of experiencing hunger.

While many schools are continuing to feed their students, we're working to fill the gaps in areas where children's needs are not being met. Children's Hunger Alliance provides free grab-and-go meals to children 18 and younger across Ohio, currently at over 70 sites and continues to add new sites daily.
